School Year Hours of Operation Beginning August 3, 2020:

- Nurse Practitioner and Medical Assistant will be available:
- Monday- 6:30 am-10:00 am and 2:30-5:30 pm
- Tuesday- 2:30 pm-5:30 pm
- Wednesday- 6:30 am-10:00 am
- Thursday- 2:30 pm-5:30 pm and
- Friday- 6:30 am-10:00 am

Scope of Services:

- “convenient care” (treatment for colds and flu) for children age 2-9
- “routine care” for individuals 10 and older
 - Most common appointment types include: sore throat, sinus infection, upper respiratory infection and acute conjunctivitis.

Employee Cost:

- **Employees/spouses/dependents on SACS Traditional Insurance Plan:**
 - Clinic Visits: FREE
 - Health Educator Visits: FREE
 - Laboratory Services: FREE
 - Wellness (lab) Screenings: FREE (requires 10-12 hour fast) (available only to employee and spouse)
 - Dispensed Pharmaceuticals: FREE
 - Onsite Programs and Healthy Focus Presentations: FREE
- **Employees/spouses/dependents on SACS HSA (health savings account) Plan:**
 - Clinic Visits: \$35.00
 - Health Educator Visits: FREE
 - Laboratory Services: \$15.00
 - Wellness Screening: FREE
 - Dispensed Pharmaceuticals: FREE
 - Onsite Programs and Health Focus Presentations: FREE
- **Employees of SACS, but not on health plan:**
 - Clinic Visits: \$50.00
 - Health Educator Visits: \$50.00
 - Wellness Screening: Cost of lab work
 - Laboratory Services: script
 - Dispensed Pharmaceuticals: script
 - Online Wellness Courses: FREE
 - Healthy Focus Presentations: FREE

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Please bear with us as we start the clinic back up.

What to expect during your visit.

Clinic staff will greet you, provide a mask (if needed), take your temperature and ask you a series of questions.

Have you had:

- A fever greater than 100.0 F (or 2.0 F greater than normal- if your temp usually runs low).
- Cough
- Shortness of Breath or difficulty breathing
- Fatigue
- Muscle or body aches
- Headache
- Loss of taste or smell
- Sore Throat
- Congestion, runny nose
- Nausea or vomiting
- Sore throat
- Diarrhea

Have you:

- Knowingly had any unprotected exposure to anyone positive for Covid-19 in the past 14 days.
- Traveled to Covid-19 hot spots within the last 14 days
- Been tested for Covid-19 and are awaiting results or have tested positive.

If you are experiencing symptoms consistent with Covid-19 you will be referred to an appropriate site for continued care.

New, at least for a little while.....

We will ask that you wait in your vehicle until called by clinic staff.

This allows for cleaning in between patients and for additional distancing in the office.
