- **SAT-** Students registered for the Homestead Parents Club **SAT** diagnostic test should arrive at Homestead Ninth Grade Academy to check-in for testing at **7:40 a.m. on Saturday, January 23, 2010**. The test will be completed by 12:30 p.m.
- **ACT-** Students registered for the Homestead Parents Club **ACT** diagnostic test should arrive at Homestead Ninth Grade Academy to check-in for testing at **7:40 a.m. on Saturday, February 20, 2010**. The test will be completed by 12:30 p.m.
- **BRING:** Please be sure to bring the following items: sharpened #2 pencils, Homestead or other school ID, calculator (four-function, scientific, or graphing is acceptable).
- **Don't Bring:** Please **do not bring** the following items: food or drink, scratch paper, notebooks, laptop, dictionary, compass, protractor, ruler, highlighter or colored pens/pencils, portable listening or recording devices of any kind or cell phones.
